COMPLAINT

Now comes Relator, Dario David Hunter (hereinafter 'Dario Hunter') and for his Complaint against Respondents, the Mahoning County Democratic Party Central Committee and David Betras, states as follows:

- 1. This is a mandamus action for a writ compelling Respondent, the Mahoning County Democratic Party Central Committee, to comply with R.C. 733.08(A) and meet to fill the current vacancy in the office of Mayor of the City of Youngstown. The aforementioned vacancy results from the former mayor-elect Jamael Tito Brown's refusal to take office as deemed by R.C. 3.30 due to his failure to timely procure bond as required by Youngstown Codified Ordinances 163.02(B).
- 2. This action in mandamus also seeks to compel David Betras, Chair of the Mahoning County Democratic Party, a position encompassing the duties of Chair of the Mahoning County Democratic Party Central Committee, to fulfill his duty under R.C. 733.08(A) mandating that either the committee Chairperson or Secretary send by mail to every member eligible to vote on filling the vacancy a written notice stating the date, time and place of the meeting and its purpose.
- This Court has jurisdiction over this original action pursuant to the Ohio Constitution,
 Article IV, Section 2(B)(1)(b).
- 4. In support of this Complaint, the Relator, Dario Hunter, has included his affidavit affirming his personal knowledge of the matters averred therein.
- Relator Dario Hunter is an Ohio citizen residing at 439 Pasadena Avenue,
 Youngstown, Ohio 44507 in Mahoning County.

- 6. Respondent the Mahoning County Democratic Party Central Committee (hereinafter 'the Central Committee') is composed of duly elected public officials all residing in Mahoning County, Ohio.
- David Betras serves as the Chair of the Democratic Party of Mahoning County and is an Ohio citizen residing at 1491 Barbie Drive, Boardman, Ohio 44512.

FACTS GIVING RISE TO RELATOR'S CLAIMS FOR RELIEF

- 8. On Nov. 7, 2018, Jamael Tito Brown (hereinafter 'Brown') was elected to serve as Mayor of the City of Youngstown, as certified by the Mahoning County Board of Elections on Nov. 22, 2017, for a term commencing January 1, 2018 as per R.C. 733.02.
- 9. Although R.C. 733.69 requires that "[e]ach officer of a municipal corporation required by law or ordinance to give bond shall do so before entering upon the duties of the office," Brown did not obtain before January 1, 2018 the Faithful Performance Bond required by Youngstown Codified Ordinances 163.02(B).
- 10. Youngstown Codified Ordinances 163.02(B) states that "[t]he Mayor, Finance Director, Law Director shall be covered by individual faithful performance bonds. The Mayor, Law Director and Finance Director shall post individual Faithful Performance Bonds for faithful performance of their duties in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per bond."

11. Failure to obtain the aforementioned bond before entering upon the duties of office created the vacancy in the office of Mayor of Youngstown that is the subject of this complaint. R.C. 3.30 provides:

A person elected or appointed to an office who is required by law to give a bond or security previous to the performance of the duties imposed on him by his office, who refuses or neglects to give such bond or furnish such security within the time and in the manner prescribed by law, and in all respects to qualify himself for the performance of such duties, is deemed to have refused to accept the office to which he was elected or appointed. Such office shall be considered vacant and shall be filled as provided by law.

- 12. Subsequent to the start of the next term of office for the Mayor of Youngstown (Jan. 1, 2018), Brown proceeded to discharge the duties of office and has continued to do so up to and including the time of this complaint's filing.
- 13. On June 14, 2018, Relator Dario Hunter served a public records request on the Youngstown City Law Director, Jeff Limbian, by electronic mail (hereinafter, "the records request") asking for "a copy of the Faithful Performance Bond for Mayor Jamael Tito Brown." A true and exact copy of the chain of email correspondence related to the records request is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 14. On June 15, 2018, the records request was also forwarded to the Law Department Secretary, Vicki Markulin.

- 15. On Jun. 21, 2018, in response to the records request, Attorney Dana Lantz provided Relator Dario Hunter with a copy of a Faithful Performance Bond for Brown as Mayor indicating a bond signing date of Feb. 21, 2018 and stating Feb. 1, 2018 as the start of the term for Mayor as well as the bond's effective date. A true and exact copy of this bond document as provided via email is included in Exhibit A (pages 10 11).
- 16. The Feb. 21, 2018 bond as provided to Relator Dario Hunter on Jun. 21, 2018 does not bear a signature from Jamael Tito Brown.
- 17. On Jun. 25, 2018, Attorney Dana Lantz provided the Relator with a copy of the Feb. 21, 2018 bond bearing the signature of Jamael Tito Brown. A true and exact copy of this bond document as provided via email is included in Exhibit A (pages 21 22).
- 18. In its response to the public records request, the Youngstown Law Director's office could not provide a Faithful Performance Bond covering the period before Feb. 1, 2018.
- 19. In a Jul. 25, 2018 email, Law Director Jeff Limbian expressed his intention to "amend" the policy effective Feb. 1, 2018 to cover Jan. 1, 2018 and onwards.
- 20. Although Youngstown City Charter 6-1A provides that "[i]n case of the death, resignation or removal of the Mayor, the President of Council shall become the Mayor and serve for the unexpired term," Brown never actually became Mayor under R.C. 3.30 due to his failure to obtain the required bond on time.
- 21. The Youngstown City Charter does not address the issue of filling a vacancy caused by a mayor-elect's inability to take office; however, R.C. 733.08(A) provides that in such a circumstance "an appointment to take the office at the beginning of the term shall be made by the members of the central committee who reside in the city where the vacancy occurs."

- 22. Despite the requirement under R.C. 733.08(A) that "[n]ot less than five nor more than forty-five days after the vacancy occurs, the specified members of the city or county committee shall meet to make an appointment to fill the vacancy," respondents have taken no steps to fulfill their duties under R.C. 733.08(A) over five months after the vacancy began.
- 23. Despite the requirement under R.C. 733.08(A) that "[n]ot less than four days before the date of the meeting the committee chairperson or secretary shall send, by mail to every member eligible to vote on filling the vacancy, a written notice stating the date, time, and place of the meeting and its purpose," no notice has been sent out for a meeting of the Central Committee to fill the present vacancy in the office of Mayor and no such meeting has been held.
- 24. Although R.C. 733.08(A) stipulates that either the committee chairperson or secretary may send out notice of the required meeting to fill a vacancy, the *Constitution and Bylaws of the Mahoning County Democratic Party*, https://docs.wixstatic.com/ugd/bef9b9_b70715a7ed17415394e29c745b149785.pdf (accessed June 26, 2017), do not enumerate such a function for the office of Secretary/First Vice Chair, restraining further actions under that position to performance of "duties requested by the chairperson."
- 25. In light of the Respondents' failure to perform their respective duties under R.C. 733.08(A), Relator Dario Hunter is filing this Complaint for a writ of mandamus.

RELATOR'S CLAIM

- 26. Former Mayor-Elect Jamael Tito Brown failed to obtain bond before entering upon the duties of office as Mayor of Youngstown, thereby under R.C. 3.30 refusing to accept the office to which he was elected and rendering that office vacant.
- 27. The Respondent the Central Committee therefore has the statutory obligation to fill the present vacancy in the office of Mayor of the City of Youngstown in accordance with R.C. 733.08(A).
- 28. The Respondent, David Betras, Chair of the Mahoning County Democratic Party, also has a statutory duty under R.C. 733.08(A) to send by mail to every member eligible to vote on filling the vacancy in the office of the Mayor of Youngstown a written notice stating the date, time and place of the meeting and its purpose.
- 29. Dario Hunter, a resident and elector in Youngstown, has the right to request a writ of mandamus to compel the Respondents to act to fulfill their obligations under R.C.
 733.08(A) and thereby fill the vacancy in the office of Mayor of Youngstown.

WHEREFORE, Relator Dario Hunter respectfully requests that this Court

- (1) Issue a Peremptory Writ in Mandamus ordering that: (a) Respondent David Betras, Chair of the Mahoning County Democratic Party, fulfill his duties under R.C. 733.08(A) by sending notice of a meeting to fill the present vacancy in the office of Mayor of Youngstown or alternatively directing that the Secretary/First Vice Chair do so. (b) Respondent the Central Committee must hold said meeting to fill the vacancy in the office of Mayor of Youngstown in accordance with R.C. 733.08(A).
 - (2) Award Relator court costs in this action; and
 - (3) Grant such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
